I started my own research, by going to the Chamber library (aka the
backroom) and reading the minutes from the 1930's. I learned much more about the
Chamber organization and how the Chamber was involved in the roads, highways and
rail systems in McPherson. There is an entry stating a "Anti-Hoarding" program was discussed – not really clear on exactly what was being "hoarded. In 1938 there is special committee appointed for promoting the need of a swimming pool and band shell. There was a proposition of a brewery discussed and the need of a calendar of events with the Chamber being the clearing house of community event; One last topic from 1938 was the suggestion that something might be done to push home industry. It was agreed that such a plan would be beneficial, that this should be studied further sometime during the year. Yes, housing has been a topic since 1938.
