An executive committee was formed to explore the possibility of partnering with an already estab-lished facility to bring a satellite clinic to McPherson County. The committee was efficient as they pre-sented their nitial findings and recommendations at a meeting four weeks later.

As the large group convened once again it was clear this mission was important and, despite the chal-lenges and ambitious goals, the room was filled with vigorous support. I encourage residents of McPherson County to learn more about the process and work together to bring a much needed health care facility to our community.

Challenges include identifying a project solicitor, lo-cating a building site, completing strategic fundrais-ing and meeting aggressive project deadlines. The new year is full of possibilities, and McPherson County has the opportunity to embark on a journey that will provide families with much needed access to affordable health care.
