

Did you know the McPherson County Food Bank conducts routine business using vol-unteers? A volunteer board of directors oversees the daily operations related to food inventory, distribution and finances. Every three months additional volunteers travel to Hutchinson to retrieve government com modities. Last month they picked up 144 cases of food!

Storage at the Food Bank has improved Storage at the Food Bank has improved greatly as a result of the recent building expansion. The community responded with generous financial support for this much needed space. I now challenge community members to explore how they can help sustain daily operations.

Donate a bag of groceries. Volunteer to sort and distribute food. Make a cash donation. Additional refrigeration is needed to store large quantities of milk, eggs and yogurt.
