## 2009 LEADERSHIP MCPHERSON CLASS PROJECT UPDATE

As a member of Leadership McPherson class, part of the cirriculum and requirement of graduation of the programs is to apply the leadership skills on a class project that benefits the youth of McPherson. The 2009 Leadership McPherson Class helped to establish two programs to provide nutritious food for children in the McPherson area.

The first project, the class became familiar with the Food 4 Kids program offered by the Kansas Food Bank. This program pro-vides backpacks of food for elementary and middle school kids each weekend of the school year. The food is delivered weekly to a central location and then is delivered to the schools and distributed to the kids in a discrete manner. This of course would not have been possible without the consent and support of the McPherson School District #418. In 2010 school year, 106 students were being provided with weekend backpacks of food, current numbers are 89 students.

The class realized that while the kids were now being nourished during the school year, September-May, what about the month they are home from summer break? After much work with local churches, organizations and foundations, the McPherson Summer Lunch Program was established. Collaborating with the United Way of McPherson and The McPherson County Community Foundation, the class worked to put the program in place; finding volunteers to purchase food, sack the food and deliver the food, finding cash and food donations to get the program funded and putting together a method for children in need
