In 2006, Rishel's decided to retire to Table Rock Lake which created the opportunity for the Odle-Mulch partnership to purchase the business and continue the growth and expansion on the 10-acre site. During the next 10 years they added six additional mini storage buildings, which was in addition to the six mini storage buildings and five RV buildings in existence at the time of the 2006 purchase.

During 2020, Evergreen Storage started a new expansion project by purchasing a 4-acre tract adjacent to the southwest of the existing Evergreen Storage property.
